Hocking Athens Perry Community Action Regional Food Center provides wholesome food products to charitable feeding programs (pantries, shelters, after school programs, soup kitchens) in Hocking, Athens, Perry, Gallia, Jackson, Lawrence, Meigs, Morgan, Vinton and Washington counties. Other services offered in those 10 counties include the Commodity Supplemental Food Program, which serves income eligible people 60 or older with a monthly nutritionally balanced food box of United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) commodities.
